## A BILL ENTITLED

## AN ACT concerning

Community Reinvestment and Repair Commission; and Community Reinvestment and Repair Special Revenue Fund

FOR the purpose of creating a Community Reinvestment and Repair Commission to make recommendations for the use of funds received from the State Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund; establishing the purpose and duties of the Commission; providing for the composition of the Commission; requiring certain reports; defining certain terms; establishing the Community Reinvestment and Repair Special Revenue Fund for the purpose of receiving funds from the State Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund; providing that the Community Reinvestment and Repair Special Revenue Fund shall be a special, non-lapsing fund; and generally relating to boards, commissions, and similar bodies, and finance.

8	ACTIVITIES.
9	(C) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND MAY
10	NOT SUPPLANT FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR PRE-
11	EXISTING COUNTY PROGRAMS.

14	from the date of its enactment.
