- 9 B. General provisions. Signage shall be constructed in an unobtrusive manner which compliments 10 the architectural elements of quality, style, color and material of the building, and the 11 architectural period of the building(s). The following broad categories of sign types are
- regulated by this section unless otherwise provided herein:
- (3) Wall signs. Wall signs shall include all flat signs which are placed against a building or 13 other structure and attached to the exterior front, rear or side wall of any building or other 14 structure. Flat wall mounted signs may be located on any wall of a building and may extend not 15 more than 8 feet above the parapet wall or roofline of the building to which they are attached. 16 However, no window, or part of a window, shall be covered by the sign area or its supporting 17 structure. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR HEREIN, ELECTRONIC 18 MESSAGE BOARDS ARE PERMITTED AS WALL SIGNS IN THE B1, B2, B3, CI, LI 19 AND GI ZONING DISTRICTS. ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARDS SHALL NOT 20 EXCEED 20 SQUARE FEET IN SIZE, AND SHALL DISPLAY ONLY ON-PREMISES 21 22 MESSAGES, OR TIME AND/OR TEMPERATURE DISPLAYS. AN ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARD SHALL CONSIST ONLY OF ALPHABETIC OR NUMERIC 23 CHARACTERS AND SHALL NOT INCLUDE ANY GRAPHIC, PICTORIAL OR 24

- 1 PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGES OR VIDEOS. THE APPEARANCE OF ANY ANIMATION. 2 MOTION, FLASHING, BLINKING OR SHIMMERING IS NOT PERMITTED. A SINGLE 3 MESSAGE, OR SEGMENT OF A MESSAGE, SHALL HAVE A DISPLAY TIME OF AT 4 LEAST 2 SECONDS, INCLUDING THE TIME NEEDED TO MOVE THE MESSAGE 5 ONTO THE SIGN BOARD, WITH ALL SEGMENTS OF THE TOTAL MESSAGE TO BE DISPLAYED WITHIN 10 SECONDS. ONLY ONE ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARD SHALL BE PERMITTED ON A PREMISE WHETHER IT BE A FREESTANDING 10 SIGN OR A WALL SIGN. 11
