- WHEREAS, the Maryland General Assembly enacted the Cannabis Reform Act of 2023
- 2 (the "Act") that established the Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund (the "Fund"), which
- 3 allocates a portion of tax revenue generated from adult-use cannabis sales to local jurisdictions;
- 4 and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the Fund is to support community-based initiatives that benefit
- 6 low-income communities and communities that have been disproportionately impacted by the
- 7 enforcement of cannabis prohibition; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Act requires each jurisdiction that desires an allocation of a portion of
- 9 State cannabis tax revenues to adopt a law establishing the purpose for which money received from
- the Fund may be used.
- 11 NOW THEREFORE,
- 12 Section 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Harford County, Maryland that a new Article
- 13 IX, Harford County Community Reinvestment and Repair Fund be, and is hereby, added to
- 14 Chapter 123, Finance and Taxation, of the Harford County Code, as amended, to read as follows:
- 15 Chapter 123. Finance and Taxation
- 16 Article IX. HARFORD COUNTY COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AND REPAIR FUND
- 17 §123-72. PURPOSE AND INTENT
- 18 A. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 1-322 OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND
- 19 CANNABIS ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, THE
- 20 COUNTY HEREBY ESTABLISHES A COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AND
- 21 REPAIR FUND (THE "FUND").
- 22 B. THE FUND CONSISTS OF A PORTION OF THE STATE TAX REVENUES
- GENERATED FROM ADULT-USE CANNABIS SALES.

- 1 C. THE FUND WILL ONLY BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS
- OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CANNABIS ARTICLE OF THE
- 3 ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND AND OTHER APPLICABLE STATE LAW
- 4 AND REGULATION.
- 5 D. MONEY MAY NOT BE EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 6 AGENCIES OR ACTIVITIES.
- 7 E. MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND MAY NOT
- 8 SUPPLANT FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR
- 9 PREEXISTING LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS THAT EXISTED PRIOR TO
- 10 JULY 1, 2023.
- 11 Section 2. And be it further enacted that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the
- date it becomes law.
