- (4) generally amend the laws governing the licensing and regulation of taxicabs.

21	<u>(b)</u>	A licensee must not use any hybrid, electric, or wheelchair accessible
22		vehicle that is older than twelve model years to provide taxicab service in

24	<u>(c)</u>	As used in this Chapter, the "model year" of a vehicle is the year
25		designated by the vehicle manufacturer, as indicated on the vehicle or in
