SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, that Section 2-537 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby	
repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

DIVISION 47. LAW ENFORCEMENT REFORM INITIATIVES.	
SUBDIVISION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGING COMMITTEE.	
Sec. 2-537. Mandatory Responsibilities of ACC.	
The ACC shall:	
(a) Review the findings of a law enforcement agency's investigation of external	
complaints, including complaints involving allegations of misconduct that occur on or off-duty	

and were not initiated by the involved citizen; and

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
