AN ACT concerning

Zoning Regulations – Uses Permitted in the B.M.-C.T. District – Elderly Housing Facilities
~~and Overcrowded School Districts~~

FOR the purpose of permitting apartments and age-restricted (55 years and older) independent dwelling units, housing for the elderly, assisted living facilities, or continuing care facilities in any story of the building in the B.M.-C.T. District in certain areas of the County, including the Owings Mills Town Center Sub Area of the Owings Mills Growth Area in the Master Plan 2020; ~~rendering the Overcrowded School Districts provisions not applicable to the development of age-restricted (55 years and older) independent dwelling units, housing for the elderly, assisted living facilities, or continuing care facilities;~~ and generally relating to uses permitted in the B.M.- C.T. District.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations read as follows:

4 ARTICLE 2 – ELEVATOR-APARTMENT RESIDENCE ZONES,
5 RESIDENTIAL-OFFICE ZONES, OFFICE ZONES, BUSINESS ZONES,
6 MANUFACTURING ZONES AND DISTRICTS

7 Section 235B – Special Regulations for C.T. Districts

8
9 § 235B.1. Apartments; elderly housing facilities.

10 Apartments shall be permitted, but only above the first story of a building, except that
11 apartments and [elderly housing facilities] AGE-RESTRICTED (55 YEARS AND OLDER)
12 INDEPENDENT DWELLING UNITS, HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY, ASSISTED LIVING
13 FACILITIES, OR CONTINUING CARE FACILITIES shall be permitted in any story of the
14 building in accordance with the following:

1 A. In the B.M. or B.M.-C.T. Zone located north of Shawan Road, west of York
2 Road, and south and east of McCormick Road within a Commercial Mixed Use Focal Point in
3 the Hunt Valley/Timonium Master Plan.

4 B. In the B.M.-C.T. Zone located [north of Lakeside Boulevard, west of Painters
5 Mill Road, south of I-795/Northwest Expressway, and east of Owings Mills Boulevard] in the
6 Owings Mills Town Center Sub Area of the Owings Mills Growth Area in the Master Plan 2020.

7 C. In the B.M.-C.T. Zone located north and west of Honeygo Boulevard, south of
8 White Marsh Boulevard, and east of Perry Hall Boulevard within the White Marsh Mall Sub
9 Area of the Middle River Redevelopment Area in Master Plan 2020.

10 D. IN THE B.M.-C.T. ZONE LOCATED SOUTH OF SECURITY
11 BOULEVARD, WEST OF I-695, NORTH OF I-70 AND EAST OF ROLLING ROAD IN THE
12 NODE-TYPE REGIONAL COMMERCIAL IN MASTER PLAN 2030.
