1 2 City of Glenarden, Maryland 2020 Legislation 3 4 5 **Charter Resolution Number:** CR-01-2020 6 Sponsor: Carolyn Smallwood 7 Co-Sponsor: Public Hearing: 8 September 17, 2019 9 Session: Regular Session 10 Date of Introduction: November 12, 2019 11 12 **Charter Resolution** 13 A CHARTER RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE VIII "FINANCE" SECTION 14 15 818 "CONTRACT PROCEDURE" 16 WHEREAS, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, 17 operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §4-301 et seq. of the 18 Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland as amended; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Section 818 of the Charter requires that any purchase over \$2,000.00 must be 21 22 purchased by formal written contract; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Section 818 of the City Charter requires items over \$2,000.00 to be put out 25 for bid and be approved by the City Council; and 26 WHEREAS, this restriction has interfered with providing goods and services to the 27 citizens of Glenarden in the most expediate manner; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, the rate of inflation has increased dramatically over the years; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the cost of goods and services has increased. 33 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED that Section 818, Contract 34 Procedure, of the Charter of the City of Glenarden be and it is hereby amended to read as 35 follows: 36 37 Section 818 Contract procedure. A. All supplies material, equipment, construction of public improvements and 38 contractual services, except as otherwise provided in this Charter, when the 39 estimated cost thereof shall exceed [\$2,000] \$6,000.00, shall be purchased by 40 formal written contract from the bidder who offers the lowest or best bid as 41

determined by the Mayor or Council as provided in this Charter, after due notice inviting bids.

- B. ANY PURCHASE MORE THAN \$2,000.00 BUT LESS THEN \$6,000.00 REQUIRES THAT NOTICE BE GIVEN TO THE CITY COUNCIL THREE (3) DAYS PRIOR TO PURCHASE. In lieu of the contract bid process required by this section, and in place of section 821 (a), (b) and (c) of this charter, whenever a federal, state, county or local government, or any agency thereof, whose purchasing polices are comparable to those of the City of Glenarden, has conducted a bid and awarded a contract, the City may purchase by contract the bid item at the bid price from the successful bidder, subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council. Prior to the City's purchase of an item, service material from a successful bidder of another jurisdiction, the City Manager shall obtain a copy of the jurisdiction's purchasing policies.
- C. IN LIEU OF THE CONTRACT BID PROCESS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, AND IN PLACE OF SECTION 821 (a), (b) AND (c) OF THIS CHARTER, WHENEVER A FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, OR ANY AGENCY THEREOF, WHOSE PURCHASING POLICIES ARE COMPARABLE TO THOSE OF THE CITY OF GLENARDEN, HAS CONDUCTED A BID AND AWARDED A CONTRACT, THE CITY MAY PURCHASE BY CONTRACT THE BID ITEM AT THE BID PRICE FROM THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR OR COUNCIL. PRIOR TO THE CITY'S PURCHASE OF AN ITEM, SERVICE OR MATERIAL FROM A SUCCESSFUL BIDDER OF ANOTHER JURISDICTION, THE CITY MANAGER SHALL OBTAIN A COPY OF THE JURISDICTION'S PURCHASING POLICIES.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland that the amendment to the Charter of the City of Glenarden, hereby proposed by this enactment, adopted this 12th day of November, 2019, shall be and become effective upon the fiftieth (50th) day after its passage by the City unless petitioned to referendum in accordance with §4-301 et seq. of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland within forty (40) days following its passage. A complete and exact copy of this Charter Resolution shall be posted in the City offices located at 8600 Glenarden Parkway, Glenarden, Maryland for forty (40) days following its passage by the Mayor or Council and a fair summary of the Charter Resolution shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City not less than four (4) times, at weekly intervals, also within the forty (40) day period following its adoption by the City.
