## RESOLUTION 2025-04 CHARTER AMENDMENT

## RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SMITHSBURG, MARYLAND, TO AMEND THE CORPORATE CHARTER §31-26. Same, duties.

**RESOLUTION** of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Smithsburg, Maryland, adopted pursuant to Article XI-E, Section 4, of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, entitled, "MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, PROCEDURES FOR ADOPTION, AMENDMENT OR REPEAL OF CHARTERS", and pursuant to §4-304 entitled "Initiation of charter amendment by legislative body," to amend §31-26 to the Corporate Charter of the Town of Smithsburg as adopted entitled *Same*, *duties*.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Smithsburg deem it in the best interest of the Town of Smithsburg and the community to amend said Charter.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Smithsburg, Maryland, that §31-26 entitled *Same*, *duties* be and is hereby repealed in its current form; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that §31-26 be and is amended and re-enacted in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 31-26. Same, duties. Board of Supervisors of Elections.

The board of supervisors of elections shall be in charge of the registration of voters, nominations, and all town elections. The board may appoint election clerks or other employees to assist it in any of its duties. Unless the alternate member is serving as regular member as specified in Section 31-24, the alternate member may assist with the duties of the board of supervisors of elections as needed and assigned by the board.

And be it further **RESOLVED** that the exact text of the proposed Charter Amendment prepared so that each provision is shown as the provision would read when amended or enacted is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and is incorporated herein by reference; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, Local Government Article, §4-303(d) the proposed Amendment specifically repeals and/or is intended to repeal and/or amend any provision in the Charter for the Town of Smithsburg that is inconsistent with the Amended provision; and be it is further

RESOLVED, that notice is further given that the Amendment proposed by the Legislative Body of the Town of Smithsburg Maryland, that the Municipal Charter according to this Amendment, shall be effective and observed as such, in all respects set forth above on the fiftieth (50<sup>th</sup>) day after passage, as set forth above, unless on or before the fortieth (40<sup>th</sup>) day after passage there shall be presented to the Mayor and Council

(Legislative Body) or mailed to it by registered mail, a petition for referendum in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Local Government Article.
